AOC annually processes over 400,000 locate requests across Alberta and also serves Saskatchewan and Manitoba.

The Alberta Common Ground Alliance is a multi-stakeholder organization dedicated to the prevention of damage to buried facilities through the adoption of effective ground disturbance and damage prevention best practices.
