For marking underground utility lines

WHITE - proposed excavation
PINK - temporary survey markings
RED - electrical, lighting cables
YELLOW - gas, oil, steam
ORANGE - telephone, cable, TV, signals, alarms
BLUE - potable water
GREEN - sanitary and storm sewers, culverts
PURPLE - reclaimed water, irrigation, slurry lines

Coloured locate markers, stakes, flags or paint, should be of sufficient quantity and within close proximity to each other to clearly identify the horizontal alignment of the buried utilities.

Please note that Utility Safety Partners do not perform locates.

STEP

Your Responsibility:



You submit your locate request online or by phone.

24hrs/day – 7 days/week

Monday through Friday (except holidays) during regular business hours

Submit your request a *minimum* of 3 to 5 business days in advance of when you will be ready to start work. Response times may be longer during the busy season.



Utility Safety Partners Responsibility:

We notify our registered asset owners of your digging project.

Utility Safety Partners will:

- Assign a ticket number to your locate request; and
- Notify registered asset owners with buried utilities in the vicinity of the dig site.

The owners of utilities receive the locate request from Utility Safety Partners, determine whether or not the proposed ground disturbance will be in conflict with their assets, then respond to the excavator.

STEP

Facility Owner Responsibility:

Our registered asset owners locate and mark their buried utilities.

After the minimum notice period has passed, utility operators are expected to:

- identify and mark the location of their utilities; or
- contact you to arrange a mutually acceptable time to complete the locate; or
- provide written clearance to proceed with your project without a locate.

Important: You must wait until all utility owners have identified the location of their assets before you start your project.
